Youth Opportunities Program

Eligibility requirements for the **FREE** Youth Opportunities Program:

- Youths aged 15 to 30 (inclusive).
- Must be unemployed, not on Employment Insurance, and not registered with another youth employment program with any other agency.
- A Canadian citizen, or permanent resident, or a protected person as defined by the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act.
- Legally entitled to work in Canada, have a Picture ID, and a SIN Card valid for employment.
- Resident of Peel Region.

Registered Youths Must Attend:

- 3 counselling sessions as arranged with a clinician, with the Counselling Program at Family Services of Peel
- 3 weeks (15 days) of workshops for 6 hours per day, 5 days per week.
- 4 weeks (20 days) of employment training for 6 hours per day, 5 days per week.
- 12 weeks (60 days) of employment for 7 hours per day, 5 days per week.

Youth Opportunities Program

Youth Opportunities Program Details:

- Eligible and registered youths will be paid for the hours that they attend the program, for up to 19 weeks.
- Youths will receive training and learn valuable on-the-job skills that will add to their work experience.
- Youths will receive certification after successful program completion.
